



Position: Minister of Worship and Technology

Reports to: Lead Pastor

Hours: Full-Time

Purpose: The Minister of Worship and Technology is responsible for: Overseeing and providing leadership for a high quality, gospel centered, worship and technology ministry.

Position Overview

- Collaborates with the Lead Pastor to construct all worship experiences.
- Provides leadership and direction for the worship music staff.
- Directs and manages the technology program of the church.
- Manages the technology of all worship services, broadcasts, and special events

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Music teams:

- Direct and grow the music ministry of the church.
- Recruit, train, and maintain musicians for music teams.
- Mentor Middle School and High School students in becoming leaders within our bands.
- Encourage exposure of worship ministries on Wednesdays/Sundays and beyond our walls.
- Supervises the Director of Vocal Music, Director of Keyboard Ministry, Director of Handbell Music, Summer Music Intern.

Worship:

- Lead all contemporary worship services and rehearsals to prepare for these services.
- Lead worship at special events and programs beyond Wednesdays/Sundays.
- Collaborate with the Lead Pastor in the construction of worship series, sermons, and regularly preach.
- Manage “front of house” equipment and budget.
- Develop growth group curriculum and strategies to align with planned worship experiences.

Technology

- Responsible for all technology used in worship services, broadcasts, rehearsals, and special events.
- Recruit and train all technology volunteers.
- Discern, map, and direct use of technology for all sanctuary events.
- Manage “back of house” equipment and budget.
- Supervise-the Technology Associate.

General Administrative Tasks:

- General administrative responsibilities as assigned by the Staff Parish Relations Committee and Lead Pastor.
- Assist the Lead Pastor in the leadership of the entire church staff.

Qualifications:

Education and Credentials:

- Bachelor’s degree in Ministry, Music, Mission, or related field.
- Experience in Church technology operation and direction.
- Participate in continuing education workshops to maintain professional credentials.
- Minimum of 2 years previous worship and/or mission experience.
